

- 1. This tournament shall be sanctioned through the USBC. This tournament is open to all USBC Youth bowlers and anyone U20 as long as they have NOT competed for cash prizes. Team Division competition will be based on the highest aged bowler on the team.
 - Any bowler not sanctioned in Ocean County must present a valid 2025-2026 sanction card. Any bowlers who are competing for Junior Gold must carry a current 2025-2026 Junior Gold membership (prior to 1st ball thrown).
- 2. All bowlers must be properly attired. Teams are encouraged to dress as a team and/or in clothes for the season. Some examples of unacceptable attire: see-through blouses, baggy pants below the waist or army fatigue jackets will not be permitted. No hats or caps. No vulgarisms on articles of clothing will be permitted. No iPods, air pods, cell phones, or other electronic items in bowling area during bowling.
- 3. Entry Fee: Scratch and Handicap Division is \$50.00 for the team \$30.00 for lineage and \$20.00 toward scholarships. There shall be three guaranteed team scholarship awards in each division; additional scholarships may be awarded based on entries and the USBC ratio guidelines. All scholarship awards will be returned 100%. THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS
- **4. Scratch Division and Handicapped Divisions** will bowl on the same "Modified House Pattern." All bowlers will bowl 4 games across two pairs of lanes. Top three teams will move on to a "2 Baker game total wood" stepladder finals. A tie in the qualifying round in either division will be resolved by the highest team game being awarded the higher seed.
- **4a. Handicap bowlers-** Handicap is 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 230. Averages will be based on their highest 2025-2026 winter average as of December 19, 2025, with a minimum of 18 games. Bowlers with no current ('25-'26) average will use their 2024-2025 book average of at least 18 games. Bowlers with no averages listed above will be assigned a 230 entering average.

All HANDICAP DIVISION BOWLERS MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF AVERAGE.

5. Junior Gold Qualifying – All Junior Gold members will be competing independently, whether they are bowling in the Scratch or the Handicap division. The top (eligible U-16 & U-18 Junior Gold) boys and girls finisher after four games will receive a 2026 Junior Gold Tournament entry. Please note that in order to award a Junior Gold spot, there must be at least 4 entrants in that division. If a lack of entrants in any division occurs, the boys and girls will move upward in age group before being combined, if necessary.

In the event of a tie for winning a Junior gold entry, there will be a one game individual roll off.

One entry awarded in both the girls and boys in the U-16 & U-18 divisions.

- **6.** No altering of a ball surface for the entire tournament, once competition begins. (See USBC Rule 18) Violation of this rule: 1st offense Ball removed from play; 2nd offense Disqualification
- 7. This tournament is scheduled to start at 8:30 with 10 minutes of practice. Check in will be at 8:00 am. A bowler who arrives after the start of the tournament will receive a zero pin fall for all missed frames. Late bowlers will not be permitted to practice.
- **8.** Please make all checks payable to Ocean Lanes.
- 9. Any rules not specifically covered by these tournament rules, will be in accordance with USBC rules.
